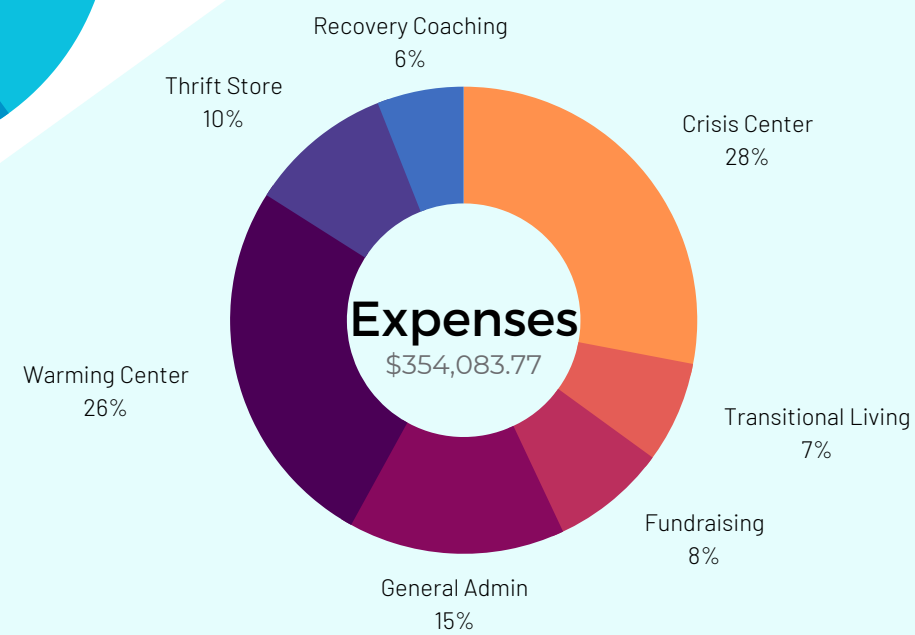
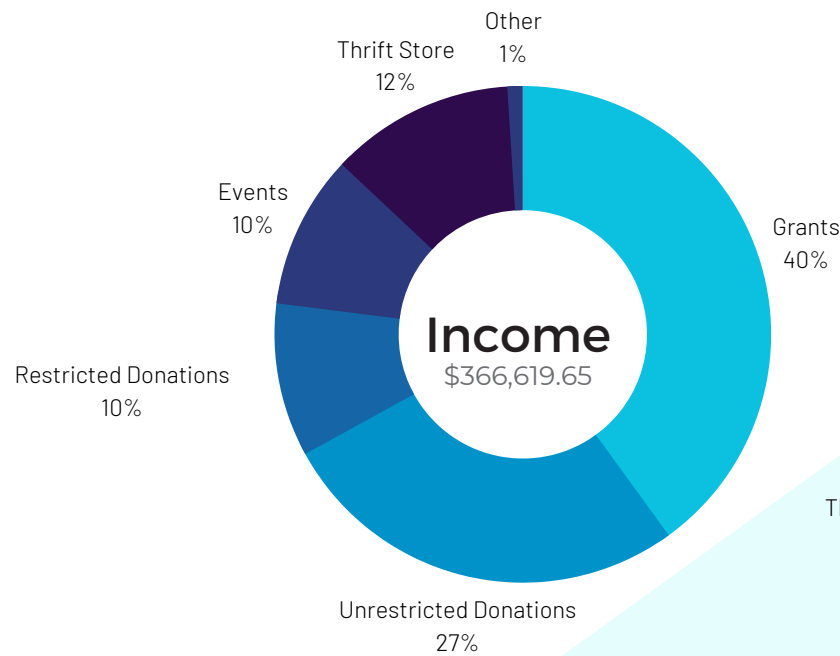


Financial Overview

What We Do

CRISIS INTAKE

- We accept initial intake appointments Tuesdays and Thursdays each week to gather the information needed to help.

CRISIS MANAGEMENT

- The next step is to assess each guest's situation and find out how Foundations for Living can come alongside them to help.

MIDDLETON HOUSE

- The Middleton House was donated in 2022 and is currently undergoing a full remodel. The home will open in late summer as a women's transitional living home.



WARMING CENTER

- We accept guests into the center from Nov 1st through April 30th from 7:00 PM – 7:00 AM and provide shelter and respite from the elements. Last year, the Warming Center provided over 1,560 nights of sleep and care.
